Please leave your name, the number of people and your telephone number. The church message machine will note when we have reached our capacity. This will be the norm until further notice. Please do not come if you have been ill, or have been close to someone who is ill or have travelled outside Canada. Masks will be worn at all times; contact tracing, physically distancing, and sanitizing also all required.
